BizBotics Quality Manager

Your business is responsible for producing JA BizTown tokens out of pennies using the penny press, with the help of a robot. Make sure you are familiar with your responsibilities and the safety instructions.

1. Meetings

Attend any meetings called by the CEO or Volunteer.

2. Carefully read Robot Instructional & Safety Manual

You will assist the Automation Engineer and the Production/Machine Operator when one or the other is on break today.

3. Quality Manager Checklist

Fill out your **Quality Manager Assessment Checklist**. You are responsible for making sure your products are of good quality.

4. Check the Date Worksheet

Take one roll of pennies from your supplies before they are pressed and work on the **Check the Date Worksheet**. When you are done, give the pennies to the Automation Engineer.

5. White Board

Keep track of the rate of production. Use the whiteboard to track the robot's **ACTUAL** run rate. Write down the number of approved units and not approved units the robot produces **per hour**. Work hard to help your business meet your production goal and make the highest quality product possible.

6. Penny Containers

Put pennies not approved in the container labeled "Not Approved Pennies/Tokens" in your business. Put the approved pennies in the container labeled "Approved Pennies/Tokens."

7. Deliver Non-Approved Pennies

- a. Count out 12 non-approved pennies from the penny jar.
- b. Put them in the container marked Non-Approved Pennies for Town Treasures.
- c. Take the container to the **Jewelry Manufacturer** in Town Treasures for making necklaces for the next day's school in *JA BizTown*.
- d. Once you give the pennies in the container to the Jewelry Manufacturer, <u>be sure</u> to take the container back to your business.

9. Clean Up

Assist with business clean up at the end of the day.
